NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

Rules Applying to Dog Shows

Effective January 1, 2010

CHAPTER 11, SECTION 1.

No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration.

See <http://www.akc.org/pdfs/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf> for complete detail of the rule change.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The Show Site will be available FOR RV/CAMPER PARKING ONLY at 8:00 AM on Thursday, December 3, 2009. Twenty foot wide space with hookup - \$25.00 per day for 30 amp service, \$40.00 per day for 50 amp service; without hookup - \$10.00. Space available on a first-come, first-served basis - space cannot be reserved. RV/camper parking in designated areas only and will be directed by fairgrounds personnel. No hookups may be run inside building. RVs/campers arriving Monday, Tuesday, or Wednesday will be charged \$35.00 per day for 30 amp service, \$50.00 per day for 50 amp service.

All grooming will be open at 6:00 pm & close at 10:00 pm on Thursday. Friday, Saturday & Sunday from 6:00 am to 8:00 pm. Reserved grooming will be posted on entry ways. Please, No Dogs in the Main Hall before 7:00 am Friday. Main Hall will open at 7:00 am Friday & at 7:00 am Saturday & Sunday. All doors will be locked at 10:00 pm on Friday & Saturday nights. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging on Sunday, December 6, 2009.

Parking for **handicapped exhibitors** on the west side near the center of the building (see map). Vehicles must display handicap sticker or handicap license plate.

Loading/unloading at SW and NW corner of building (see map). Headlights must be on while loading/unloading.

GROOMING AREA WILL BE MONITORED, STACKING OF CRATES WILL BE ENFORCED, AS WILL NO SAVING OF SPACE. NO SOFT CRATES.

No private exercise pens, 3 x 3 puppy pens, or rugs are permitted in the building. Space provided for ex-pens outdoors on the west side of building. **No ex-pens or crates allowed under overhang.**

Dogs shall not be left unattended on grooming tables or in ex-pens.

Crates must be stacked; **NO SOFT CRATES.** The Show Committees reserve the right to limit the number of grooming tables because of space limitations. Open grooming space **WILL NOT** be saved; it will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. Grooming area will be monitored by the Edwardsville Illinois Kennel Club, Inc. grounds committee, as well as Friday group club show committees. EIKC has the right to limit number of grooming tables, if necessary. No chairs in grooming area.

No crates or grooming equipment in the Main Hall or outside under the canopy except as follows: There will be a ringside holding area for crates & ringside table at the toy dog ring(s). **All of the aforementioned areas may be used ONLY while showing. Crates must be removed immediately after showing.**

No dogs to be left in cars or vans with windows closed. Clubs reserve the right to remove overheated dogs from vehicles by whatever means necessary.

A Paramedic Ambulance will be on call Friday, Saturday and Sunday during show hours.

No unentered dogs.

No advertising or flyers may be placed without permission of the show-giving clubs and fairgrounds personnel.

HOTELS:

Exhibitors are expected to maintain their premises & their dogs (both at hotels & on the show grounds) in a quiet, clean & well-kept manner. Hotels have been requested to report violations to the show-giving clubs. Offenses may result in an Event Committee hearing.

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed. Trophies not claimed will become the property of the show-giving clubs.

Ramps may be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. (In an emergency situation, an exhibitor does have the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund)

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.
