NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The show site will be available to exhibitors at 12:00 noon on Wednesday, June 6, 2007. All dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Breed judging on Sunday, June 10, 2007.

Rv/Overnight Parking Guidelines

Overnight and/or RV parking permitted only on gravel & blacktop lots above the show rings. Limited electrical hookups available. No reserved parking. Parking available on a first-come basis. No parking space will be reserved or saved by individuals other than the Cluster Parking Committee. Space has been allowed for awning and ex-pens. The Cluster Parking Committee will be in charge of all parking & available to assist in your parking needs. Parking in the lower area will be for handlers, box vans and other exhibitors. No saving of space with cones unless done by the Cluster Parking Committee. Overnight Access: A security guard will be on hand from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm to allow access to the facility through the gate. From 8:00 pm to midnight, gates are closed, but access to and from the facility is still possible. A security guard will be at the gate each hour on the hour to allow overnight guests on the premises between midnight and 7:00 am. To exit, the gates will automatically open. If you arrive after midnight, please park on the "Blacktop" area. The Cluster Parking Committee will assign you a parking area in the morning.

Crating & Grooming

Please stack crates under grooming tents. No permanent parking in the grooming area. When unloading at the grooming tents, please follow signs and directions of parking attendants. Unload in a timely manner and move your vehicle to one of the exhibitor parking areas as directed. In this way, all exhibitors will be able to unload. Please cooperate with the Cluster in our effort to help all exhibitors and their dogs have access to and from the rings. Crating is allowed ringside 15 minutes prior & 15 minutes after scheduled class in which handlers and their dogs are competing (per Purina Farms Events Policy). Please remove your crates or tables immediately after the judging of your breed. This will allow other exhibitors to use the crating area for their breed. Please use "Holding Area" for small dog crates and tables as this will allow the exhibitors the room needed to get into and out of the ring with their dogs. The show committee will enforce the placing of crates around the show area if need be.

Exhibitors & Guests

No one is permitted anywhere that is marked "Employees Only" and/or "No Admittance" as these are feeding research controlled areas. These are separate divisions of Purina and are not part of the show grounds. Any violations may result in the end of all dog events at Purina's beautiful facility. Purina and the Event Committee may deal with violators.

PLEASE pick up after your dog and help us keep the "Grounds" neat and clean. Purina has provided clean-up items for your use in helping with this matter. Neglect and abuse by owners and handlers of this policy could result in the loss of the use of this show site. The Cluster thanks everyone for their support of the "clean up after your dog" program. No dogs are to be left on grounds unattended overnight. Food is available on grounds.

Due to the terrain of Purina Farms, handicapped persons may have great difficulty accessing the show rings. There will be VERY LIMITED handicap parking. All vehicles utilizing handicap parking areas must have a handicap license or display a valid handicap tag at all times. Vehicles without this designation will be required to move.
