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***** **FIELD TRIAL LOCATION*******

DIRECTIONS:

The grounds are located near Coulterville, IL approximately 50 miles south of St. Louis, MO. Going **East on I-64** from (St. Louis) take Interstate 64 East to Exit 23, Route 4, Mascoutah. Go South on Rt 4 to Rt 13.. Turn left (East) on Rt 13 to Coulterville. After getting into Coulterville follow directions listed below. Going **West on I-64** take Exit 50 Rt 127 South to Pinckneyville, IL. At the intersection of Rt 127 and Rt 13 turn right (West) onto Rt 13 to Coulterville. In Coulterville watch for the Pistol City Restaurant. It will be on the NW corner of the intersection of Rt 13 and Nashville Road, CR 16. Turn North on Nashville Road, crossing the railroad tracks. Proceed northward about 2 more miles to Violet Road. Turn right (E) on Violet Road. The Belclaire Beagle Club is on your left (North) about 1 mile from your turn. **Watch for Field Trial Signs.** Please check an Illinois state map for the best routes for you to get to the site from the south thru Chester, IL. After you get into Coulterville on Rt 13 watch for the Pistol City Restaurant and follow the directions listed above to the club grounds. See Map below. **Watch for Field Trial Signs**



ENTRY FEE: \$20.00 per entry for all stakes. No charge for Best of Open, or Absolute Run. **Make checks payable to DCSTL.** Be sure to bring your dogs' entry information with you. Dogs **must be present** on the grounds at the time entries close to be officially entered. Owner is responsible for correct information on the entry forms. You may copy the enclosed form if you need more forms. Additional information can be found on the Dachshund Club of St. Louis, Inc. website at www.dachshund-stl.org.

RUNNING ORDER: Classes may run concurrently depending on entries and conditions. Saturday classes, if run concurrently, will be OAAB & FCB at the same time and OAAD & FCD at the same time depending on entries and conditions. If run consecutive the order is as follows: on Sunday ; OAAD, OAAB, FC, Best of Open, and Absolute. The committee reserves the right to make changes as needed to expedite the event.
